

A two-day Vice Chancellor's conference was held on 19th-20th May 2023 in BUITEMS Quetta, which was presided by Hon'ble Governor Balochistan and Chancellor Public Sector Universities (PSUs) Malik Abdul Wali Khan Kakar and attended by Vice Chancellors and Pro-Vice Chancellors of all PSUs of Balochistan, MPAs, Administrative Secretaries and HEC officials. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir (TI) and Pro-Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Syed Manzoor Ahmed represented the University of Gwadar at the VC's Conference.

The delegates in different sessions held discussions and deliberations on universities' financial, administrative, and academic issues and matters, and proposed policy recommendations in the shape of a strategic plan for short-term, medium-term, and long-term measures to ensure the sustainability of PSUs. 


Welcome party arranged by UG Senior Students for Fresh Students




The senior students of the University arranged a welcome party in the Honor of newcomers to the seminar Hall of the University.

New students of the University were relieved to see their seniors arranging such events for them which will encourage them to work harder in their studies.





Vice Chancellor University of Gwadar formally inaugurated one-year diploma courses at PCTVI

In the Eighth Gwadar Book Festival, the University of Gwadar (UG), organized two sessions on "Great Power Rivalry or Cooperation? Gwadar, Pakistan, and Geo Economics," and "Blue Economy, key to Development for Makran Coast" on February 25th and 26th 2023 in RCDC Gwadar. The keynote speaker of the first session was Senator Mushahid Hussain Syed, Other panelists at the discussion included: Dr. Aqdas Afzal, Program Director Habib University, Mir Sher Baz Khetran Research Fellow at the Institute of Strategic Studies (ISSI), and the second session speakers was Dr. Nuzhat Khan Former Director General National Institute of Oceanography and CEO of Blue Net+, Dr. Hafeez Jamali, Scholar/ Social Anthropologist The discussion was moderated by PVC Dr. Syed Manzoor Ahmed, Pro Vice-Chancellor University of Gwadar. Senator Mushahid Hussain underlined the need for proactively promoting CPEC, which is the flagship of the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI), which he termed the most significant diplomatic and developmental





initiative in the 21st Century. He further waits for that the axis of CPEC is Gwadar. Integrated coastal zone management and strict enforcement of national and international environmental laws to protect the sea and its resources were also emphasized by the speakers. At the end of the session, there was a question-and-answer segment in which the participants asked questions to the panelists.


