

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# INTRODUCTION

The University of Gwadar (UG), a multidisciplinary public-sector institution, was chartered by the Government of Balochistan in 2021 and is located in Sarawan Avenue, New Town Phase-IV, District Gwadar. Before its transformation into a full-fledged university, UG functioned as a sub-campus of the University of Turbat (UoT) from 2017 to 2021. The charter of UG was passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan on November 3, 2018, assented to by the Honorable Governor on November 19, 2018, and notified in the Provincial Gazette on October 20, 2019.

UG's establishment as an autonomous university was made possible by the collective efforts of campus employees, the Higher Education Commission (HEC), federal and provincial governments, public representatives, and civil society. The leadership of Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir (TI) as the first Vice-Chancellor, and Dr. Syed Manzoor Ahmed as the Pro Vice-Chancellor, laid the foundation for the institution's rapid progress. The university is supported by a dedicated team of faculty and administrative staff, positioning it as one of the fastest-growing higher education institutions in the country.

Currently, UG operates with two faculties encompassing seven departments, offering quality education to over 1,000 students. The university employs approximately 60 highly qualified faculty and administrative staff who are committed to delivering research-led teaching and fostering entrepreneurial skills. UG provides equal opportunities to students from across the country, focusing on empowering the youth of Balochistan, particularly from remote and underdeveloped regions like Gwadar and neighboring districts.

The university boasts state-of-the-art facilities, including academic blocks, classrooms, lecture theaters, video conference halls, computer labs, a cafeteria, student facilitation centers, hostels, a seminar hall, and libraries. UG is well-connected to the Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN), ensuring fast internet connectivity for students, faculty, and staff.

UG is committed to student development, offering various extracurricular and academic activities. The university has hosted seminars, workshops, training sessions, sports festivals, book fairs, and exposure visits. Events like Paigham-e-Pakistan initiatives, certification courses in IT and entrepreneurship, and business galas aim to enhance students' skills and broaden their horizons.

The Financial Aid Office provides scholarships such as the Ehsaas Undergraduate

Scholarship, BEEF, HEC Need-Based Scholarship, UG Merit-Based Scholarship, Pakistan Baitulmal Scholarship, and the Chinese Ambassador Scholarship. These initiatives ensure that deserving students have access to higher education without financial barriers.

UG's Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) is fully operational per HEC guidelines, ensuring high standards in teaching and research. It conducts faculty training workshops, prepares self-assessment reports, and evaluates teaching effectiveness. The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) works to strengthen industry linkages, promoting research aligned with market demands. UG has signed multiple MoUs with national and international institutions to facilitate knowledge exchange and skill development.

Since its inception, UG has successfully conducted statutory body meetings, including Academic Council, Finance and Planning Committee, and Syndicate meetings. The university also publishes a biannual newsletter, "GWADARIAN," highlighting its milestones and achievements.



# Directorate of Students Affairs


## Introduction





### INTRODUCTION

The University of Gwadar, the only multidisciplinary public sector university in Balochistan, transitioned from a sub-campus of the University of Turbat (2017-2021) into an autonomous institution. Recognizing the strategic significance of CPEC, Gwadar Port, and establishing Special Economic Zones in Balochistan, the university established the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor Study Centre (CPECSC) in October 2022. The center focuses on CPEC's socio-economic potential, organizing seminars, webinars, and conferences to explore its sustainability and development. Prof. Dr. Manzoor Ahmed, the Pro Vice-Chancellor and an esteemed economist serves as its founding director.

### VISION

To strengthen economic, social, and geopolitical cooperation between China and Pakistan on the CPEC platform.

### MISSION

To build strategic cooperation between the two countries, particularly in business, economics, and geopolitics, while promoting CPEC as a game-changing initiative for Pakistan, China, and neighboring nations.

### OBJECTIVES

To study the geo-strategic and geo-economic dimensions of the Chinese Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) and CPEC to understand their long-term impacts on Pakistan. To develop the capacity of universities and to provide policy input to governments on the challenges emerging in the wake of the implementation of the CPEC long term plan. To develop an understanding of Chinese history, culture, and the governance system that has created the Chinese miracle while drawing lessons for our own development.

## UG Hosts Virtual Seminar on CPEC and Federalism in Pakistan

The CPEC Study Center at the University of Gwadar hosted a virtual seminar on “CPEC and Federalism in Pakistan,” featuring Dr. Filippo Boni from The Open University, UK, as the keynote speaker. Dr. Boni discussed CPEC's national and provincial impacts, highlighting the preference for the eastern route over the western route and the need for greater provincial inclusion through platforms like the Council of Common Interests (CCI). He also praised initiatives like the Pakistan-China Technical and Vocational Institute (PCTVI) for fostering Gwadar's socio-economic development. The session ended with a Q&A.

Irshad Ahmed Buledi, Director of ORIC at the University of Gwadar, led a delegation from the Government of Balochistan to the Chinese Embassy in Islamabad. Discussions focused on strengthening Pakistan-China ties, particularly in academic and research cooperation. The University of Gwadar (UG) has been named one of the members of the CPEC Consortium of Universities.
